



A Light in the Darkest Corners of Ecuador — STORY FROM LATIN AMERICA

Lucía lives just outside the city of Guayaquil, Ecuador, in the troubled neighbourhood of Sergio Toral. Here, many young children are exposed to violence, drugs and abuse.

“When we started working here, we heard a lot about theft and violence,” Lucía says. “But many of these problems arise because our neighbours have not heard that there is a God who can fill their lives instead!” With this call from Jesus in her heart, Lucía has started to share the Gospel where she and her husband live. They have created a space

where children can come to hear the Bible and its teachings. “We share with them that there is a God who loves them and who gave His life for them,” she says. “We tell them that they are not alone.”

Children attend the Bible club every Sunday. There they listen to the Word of God and learn how to share it with their friends. Lucía is excited to teach them. “Through the children, parents have come, and now they are also hearing the Word of God — some already want to be baptized!” Lucía exclaims.

Since starting her ministry, violence and robberies in Sergio Toral have decreased. There are also fewer reports of abuse.

“This world is so damaged and so in need of God’s love,” adds Lucía. She will continue to share the Word of God in Sergio Toral until the whole community comes to know Jesus!

TO HAVE CHILDLIKE FAITH IS A BLESSING.



Finding Purpose and Worth in Jesus — STORY FROM INDIA

Vedesh felt worthless. With his wife and child, he was living in a cramped and windowless one-room home in the slums of India's Gujarat state. Here, Vedesh and his family endured yellow drinking water, inadequate washrooms, and local crime, as well as mosquitos that caused frequent outbreaks of diseases like dengue, chikungunya and malaria.

A man named Sabbir recognized the neighbourhood's issues. He was determined to help. Through the working of the Holy Spirit and your support, he started an adult literacy class nearby. When Vedesh heard about the classes, he eagerly enrolled. Within a couple of months, Vedesh could read and write small words.

Through a special health education training put on through the classes, Vedesh learned the importance of maintaining a good diet and keeping his home clean. He went home eager to start a new lifestyle! The very next day, Vedesh began to share what he'd learned with his neighbours. Then, he took his efforts a step further: he rounded up a group to approach the local government, requesting that the slums be treated to get rid of mosquitoes. Soon, the

slum's open sewage system was treated to address the outbreak of dengue, chikungunya and malaria. Through a community-wide effort, the number of people falling sick decreased!

Throughout his time in the adult literacy class, Vedesh noticed how Sabbir lived out his faith. When Vedesh learned more about Jesus in his class, he received Christ as his Saviour! He became so passionate about his new faith that he encouraged Sabbir to start a prayer group in his house with four other learners from the neighbourhood.

Through your support of Sabbir, God is bringing hope to this neighbourhood and freeing people from illness and unhealthy conditions. Today, the villagers continue to work hard to keep their neighbourhood clean.

God Answers Dreams in Poland — STORY FROM EASTERN EUROPE

My name is Adam. I live in Oswiecim, Poland. When I was a teenager, I had a dream. I asked myself, what can I do for God? How can I encourage others to share the Gospel? I prayed about it constantly. The desire to share the Gospel grew in me. And then, God answered. I heard about something called “Project Phillip”: a Bible study program that trains local church members in evangelism and discipleship. Each participant receives a Bible for personal use and is encouraged to become a part of a local church.

At the first Project Phillip meeting in Warsaw, I realized that this was God’s answer to my dreams. I participated in the training program for starting new churches. After a year and a half in the program, I became the coordinator for the project!

I now visit many different churches, travelling for hours on end. While I drive, I pray and give thanks to God. I asked God: please explain to me how it’s possible that I can drive for such long hours without falling asleep? God spoke to me and gave me an answer: “Because I’m allowing you to live out your childhood dream.”

God is allowing me to do the kind of work that will never cease to have meaning. I’m not only teaching Christians how to share the Gospel, but I’m also helping them understand it for themselves. I am truly grateful that the Bible League appeared in Poland. This could only have happened through God’s grace.

Pressed but Not Destroyed — STORY FROM SOUTHEAST ASIA

Indah and her family live in a closed country with a predominantly Muslim population. Christians and other religious minorities face increasing hostility and persecution from neighbours and local officials. Indah, who grew up as a Muslim, learned about Jesus through her friend, Susila. Susila gave Indah a Bible. Indah read the Bible hungrily, but when her husband saw her reading it, he became enraged and beat her.

In spite of this, Indah continued to read her Bible in the middle of the night. One night, she was

filled with so much joy that she began singing in worship. Her husband caught her. He told her that, according to Islamic law, he had the right to kill her. Indah's husband picked up a knife and stabbed her!

Indah survived the attack. Her faith grew even stronger. She told her two teenage sons about Jesus and they also accepted Christ. When her husband learned of this, he attacked them as well. They all fled to Susila's house, where Susila and his wife helped them escape. Indah's husband

pressured Susila to find out where his family went and even hired a detective to follow them. Despite these challenges, Susila — and now Indah, as well — have persevered in their ministry with the Lord's help, and many more are coming to Christ.

Learning All About Jesus at Camp — STORY FROM CANADA

Each spring, Bible League Canada partners with One Hope Canada to run “Going Deep” weekend camps across Canada. Going Deep gives youth the opportunity to learn about Christ and develop a deeper relationship with Him. Thanks to your support this past year, 194 young people were able to attend these weekend camps! John’s story is just one of many.

John told his camp counsellor, Roland, that he didn’t attend church or know much about God or the Bible. John’s mom had heard about the “Going Deep” weekend retreat through the camp’s website.

God’s covenant with His people was one of the first things John learned about that weekend. “If I understand it,” he asked, “God will love me if I follow His rules, but He won’t if I don’t follow His rules?” Roland was able to respond to John by telling him all about God’s everlasting love — a love so

unconditional, that God loved us before we could even love Him!

It was clear that John was interested in learning more about Jesus. Throughout the weekend, he kept asking big questions. Roland could see that God was tugging at John’s heart. In the final cabin time, John prayed aloud for God to teach their group more about Himself and His power for years to come.

John wants to know Jesus and he is hoping to return to camp!


